This includes the whole eastside of 7,120 sq. ft for parking lot and sidewalk, as well as a 16'X16' shed pad. Al asked the council if he should proceed. After some council discussion, council approved for Al to proceed with concrete. A new dehumidifier was purchased for the basement.

Amber sent out an email with a letter to the congregation about Sunday School this year. On September 27th we will have a congregational meeting to discuss our new SS format for this year school year.

We are still in need of teachers to teach a 15 min. lesson or lead a 15 min. craft/activity once per month.
